More than a decade after its release, Minecraft remains one of the most popular games on PCs, consoles and mobile devices. While there is no legal way to play the full version of the game without buying it, you have several options on how to get Minecraft for free. The information in this article applies to Minecraft for all platforms, including PCs, mobile devices, and game consoles. There are several ways to play Minecraft for free: Download the free trial. Play Minecraft in browser mode. Use an unauthorized hacking tool. If you have an older version of the game, you may be able to go to the latest edition for free. Your computer should have the latest java version installed to run Minecraft. Most platforms offer a free Minecraft trial, but there are limitations. You can only play with the people you invite and you won't have access to Minecraft mods. However, there is no limit to the amount of time you can play. There is an unofficial program called TLauncher that allows you to create a Minecraft account for free. Go to the TLauncher website to download the program for your operating system. TLauncher comes with additional features such as the ability to create your own custom skins. Keep in mind that TLauncher is not supported by a company that makes Minecraft, so you may encounter bugs and glitches while playing. Minecraft's latest release is called Bedrock Edition. If you purchased the Java version of Minecraft for Windows before October 19, 2018, you can upgrade to Bedrock Edition for free. All you have to do is open the web browser and log into your Mojang account. Bedrock Edition comes with a cross-platform game that means you can interact others that play on different platforms (PC, PS4, etc.). If you have an old version of Minecraft for PS4, it will be automatically updated in bedrock Edition when the game starts. Unfortunately, a free update is no longer available for One. There are no doors or lights in zombie villages, and the overall atmosphere is spooky. In Java Edition, there is a 2% chance of these spawning, but in the Bedrock Edition, it's about 30%, according to Minecraft Wiki. Events can occur in the village, too, such as raids or zombie sieges. The raid occurs when you kill the captain of the raid, which will cause the status of Bad Omen. At the entrance to the village with this status will begin a raid. The zombie sieges have a 10% chance of occurring after midnight or during a thunderstorm, as long as the village has 20 beds.
